A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to empower the Napier City Council to make
bylaws controlling the use of skateboards**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

5 **1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Napier City Council (Control of Skateboards) Empowering Act 1991.

2. Interpretation—In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires,—

10 “Council” means the Napier City Council as constituted by clause 52 of the Local Government (Hawke’s Bay Region) Reorganisation Order 1989 (*Gazette*, 1989, Volume III, page 2334):

 “Road” has the same meaning as that ascribed to it by section 2 (1) of the Transport Act 1962.

15 **3. Controlling, regulating, or prohibiting skateboards**—The Council may from time to time make such bylaws as it thinks fit regulating, controlling, or prohibiting the use of skateboards on any road or public place, including the right to seize or confiscate any skateboard used in
20 contravention of the provisions of any such bylaw.
