A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Mortgages Extension Act, 1914. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

This Act may be cited as the Mortgages Extension Amendment Act, 1915, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Mortgages Extension Act, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
