A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to limit the Powers and Rights of Mortgagees under  
existing Mortgages. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Mortgages Extension Amend- Short Title.  
ment Act, 1921.

2. (1.) Subsection one of section seven of the Statutes Repeal Section 7 of  
10 and Expiring Laws Amendment and Continuance Act, 1920, is Statutes Repeal  
hereby amended by omitting the words "thirtieth day of June, and Expiring Laws  
nineteen hundred and twenty-one," and substituting the words Amendment Act,  
"thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-two." 1920 (extending  
duration of  
Mortgages  
Extension Act,  
1918), amended.

(2.) Subsection two of section seven of the Statutes Repeal and  
15 Expiring Laws Amendment and Continuance Act, 1920, is hereby  
amended as follows:—

(a.) By omitting from paragraph (a) thereof the words "thirtieth  
20 day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-one," and  
substituting the words "thirtieth day of June, nineteen  
hundred and twenty-two"; and

(b.) By omitting from paragraph (b) thereof the words "thirtieth  
day of June, nineteen hundred and twenty-two," and  
substituting therefor the words "thirty-first day of  
December, nineteen hundred and twenty-two."
