A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Mutual Fire Insurance Act, 1903." Title BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as 5 follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mutual Fire Insurance short Title. Act Amendment Act, 1904"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Mutual Fire Insurance Act, 1903" (hereafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by Amendments of inserting after the word "owners" the words "or occupiers"; and sections 2 and 6. section six is also amended by inserting after the word "owner" the words "or occupier."

3. Section eleven of the principal Act is hereby amended by Amendment of striking out all the words after the word "ten" in the proviso to section 11. the said section.

4. The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by Amendment of striking out the word "three."
