A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Mutual Fire Insurance Act, 1903." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mutual Fire Insurance Act Amendment Act, 1905"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Mutual Fire Insurance Act, 1903" (hereafter referred to as "the principal Act"). Short Title.

10 2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting after the word "owners" the words "or occupiers"; and section six is amended by inserting after the word "owner" the words "or occupier." Amendments of sections 2 and 6.

15 3. Section eleven of the principal Act is hereby amended by striking out all the words in the proviso after the word "ten." Amendment of section 11.

4. The Schedule to the principal Act is hereby amended by striking out the word "three." Amendment of Schedule.
