A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the Marlborough Harbour Act 1958

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,
5 as follows:

1. **Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Marlborough
Harbour Amendment Act 1959, and shall be read together
with and deemed part of the Marlborough Harbour Act 1958
(hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
- 10 2. **Special Act**—This Act shall be deemed to be a special
Act within the meaning of the Harbours Act 1950.

3. Increased power to borrow—Section six of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words “seventy thousand pounds”, and substituting therefor the words “one hundred thousand pounds”.

4. Substitution of new Second Schedule—The principal Act is hereby amended by repealing the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to this Act. 5
