This Public Bill originated in the House of Repre-Sentatives, and, having this day passed as now printed, is transmitted to the Legislative Council for its concurrence.

## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to extend the Powers of the Motueka Harbour Title. Board of raising Moneys for the purpose of providing the Cost of certain Harbour Works already authorized to be constructed.

WHEREAS the Motueka Harbour Board (hereinafter Preamble, called the Board) was constituted by the Motueka Harbour Board Act, 1905: And whereas by section nine of the said Act the Board was empowered to borrow moneys for the construction or completion of harbour-works in on towards the improvement of the Mouteke
