A BILL INTITULED

An Act to enable the Masterton Hospital Contributors (a Cor- Title. poration constituted under "The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885") to sell certain Lands and Premises situate in the Small-farm Settlement of Masterton, with the Buildings thereon used as a Hospital.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to sell the lands and premises Preamble. specified in the Schedule hereto, used as a hospital, and to apply the moneys arising from the sale thereof in acquiring another site, 10 and erecting thereon buildings and premises requisite for a hospital:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Masterton Hospital Short Title.

15 Contributors Empowering Act, 1903."

2. It shall be lawful for the Masterton Hospital Contributors Power to sell land. to sell the lands described in the Schedule hereto, with the buildings thereon, either by public auction or private contract, in one or more lots, and to convey the fee-simple in the same to 20 the purchaser or respective purchasers thereof.

3. The moneys arising from such sale or sales shall be Application of the applied by the Masterton Hospital Contributors in or towards the purchase-money. purchase of lands in the Borough of Masterton or its vicinity to be selected as a site for a hospital, and in or towards erecting 25 thereon the necessary and suitable buildings therefor.

4. The lands and site when so selected and acquired, and Lands when the fee-simple thereof, shall be held by, and the same shall be purchased to vest in Masterton vested in the Masterton Hospital Contributors for the purposes Hospital of the Masterton Hospital, upon the same trusts and with and Contributors. 30 subject to the same powers, restrictions, and provisions as the

lands and premises authorised to be sold under the provisions of this Act are now subject. No. 132—2.
