BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Mercantile Law Short Title.

Further Amendment Act, 1878."

2. An acceptance of a bill of exchange is not and shall not be Bill of exchange deemed to be insufficient under any Act or law by reason only that signed by drawee. such acceptance consists merely of the signature of the drawee on such bill.
