A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make Further Provision respecting the Qualification of Title. Members of the House of Representatives.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :--

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Members of the House Short Title. of Representatives Disgualification Act, 1897."

2. No person who, being a bankrupt within the meaning of Bankrupt not to be 10 "The Bankruptcy Act, 1893," has not obtained an order of discharge date, nor to sit as under that Act shall be qualified to be nominated as a candidate for member. election, or to be elected, or to take his seat as a member of the House of Representatives, anything in "The Electoral Act, 1893," or any other Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
