A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make Further Provision respecting the Qualification of Title.
Members of the House of Representatives.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Members of the House Short Title.
of Representatives Disqualification Act, 1897.”

2. No person who, being a bankrupt within the meaning of Bankrupt not to be
qualified as candi-
date, nor to sit as
member.
10 “The Bankruptcy Act, 1893,” has not obtained an order of discharge
under that Act shall be qualified to be nominated as a candidate for
election, or to be elected, or to take his seat as a member of the
House of Representatives, anything in “The Electoral Act, 1893,”
or any other Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
