A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Monopoly Prevention Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Monopoly Prevention Amend-  
ment Act, 1912.

Short Title.

2. (1.) Part I of the Monopoly Prevention Act, 1908, shall  
continue in operation until the thirty-first day of December, nineteen  
10 hundred and *thirteen*, on which day it shall be deemed to be  
repealed.

Part I of Monopoly  
Prevention Act,  
1908, extended.

(2.) The Monopoly Prevention Amendment Act, 1910, is hereby  
repealed.
