A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to grant a Retiring Allowance to Title. Edward Mayne Esquire Sergeant-at-Arms of the House of Representatives.

W HEREAS Edward Mayne Esquire Sergeant-at-Arms of the Preamble. House of Representatives is about to resign his office on account of advanced age and it is just that a pension should be granted to him for the remainder of his life

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Mayne Pension Act $_{\rm Short\ Title.}$ 1865."

II. There shall be paid to the said Edward Mayne out of the Amount of annuity general revenue of the Colony from the date of such resignation an and days of payment annuity after the rate of two hundred pounds per annum for the term of his natural life payable quarterly on the day of
