A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Medical Practitioners' Registration Act, Title 1869."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Medical Practitioners Act, 1902"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Medical Practitioners' Registration Act, 1869" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act").

2. Where the name of any person has under section twenty-one of the principal Act been erased from the Register, he may at any time thereafter, by motion to the Supreme Court, apply to be reinstated on the Register, and the Court may order that the applicant shall be so reinstated, or that he shall be reinstated conditionally or upon terms, or may decline to make any order with or without costs.
