Title. 1. Short Title. 2. Grant of military pensions in lieu of old-age pensions in certain cases.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to provide for the Grant of Military Pensions in lieu of Time. Old-age Pensions in certain Cases.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :---

1. This Act may be cited as the Military Pensions Act, 1911.

2. (1.) Any person entitled to a pension under the Old-age Pen- Grant of military sions Act, 1908, who served as a soldier in any Maori war shall be pensions in lieu of old-age pensions 10 entitled in lieu of a pension under that Act to a military pension in certain cases. of the same amount and subject to the same conditions as an old-age pension, and all the provisions of the said Act shall extend and apply to such military pensions.

(2.) The question whether a person is entitled to a military 15 pension instead of an old-age pension shall be decided by the Magistrate to whom the application for the pension is made.
