A BILL INTITULED

- An Act to prohibit the introduction of the virus Myxoma and the rabbit flea (spilopsyllus cuniculi) into New Zealand for the control of the wild rabbit population
- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
 - 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Myxomatosis Prevention Act 1986.
- 2. Offence to introduce into New Zealand the virus Myxoma or the rabbit flea-Any person who introduces into New Zealand the virus Myxoma or the rabbit flea (spilopsyllus cuniculi) commits an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$20,000.
