## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Medical Practitioners Regis-Title. tration Act 1869."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Medical Practitioners Short Title. 5 Registration Act Amendment Act 1871."

2. In the construction of this Act the words "the said Act" shall Construction. mean "The Medical Practitioners Registration Act 1869."

3. Notwithstanding anything in the said Act contained to the Persons in practice contrary every person shall be entitled to be registered as a Medical 10 Practitioner under the said Act who shall have been in actual practice in medicine or surgery in New Zealand before the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven: Provided however that every such person shall be subject to and shall comply with the provisions of the said Act in like manner as if he were entitled to be and were making 15 application to be registered as a Medical Practitioner under the provisions of the said Act.

4. Every person who shall be registered as a Medical Practitioner Registration to be as by virtue of this Act shall for all purposes whatsoever be deemed to said Act. have been registered under the said Act.
