A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Medical Practitioners Registration Act 1869." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:—

- 5 **1.** The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Medical Practitioners Registration Act Amendment Act 1871." Short Title.
- 2.** In the construction of this Act the words "the said Act" shall mean "The Medical Practitioners Registration Act 1869." Construction.
- 10 **3.** Notwithstanding anything in the said Act contained to the contrary every person shall be entitled to be registered as a Medical Practitioner under the said Act who shall have been in actual practice in medicine or surgery in New Zealand before the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven: Provided however that every such person shall be subject to and shall comply with the provisions of the said Act in like manner as if he were entitled to be and were making Persons in practice before 1857 entitled to be registered.
- 15 **4.** Every person who shall be registered as a Medical Practitioner by virtue of this Act shall for all purposes whatsoever be deemed to have been registered under the said Act. Registration to be as effectual as if under said Act.
