A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The Miners' Representation Act Title. 1862."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

- 1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Miners' Represshort Title.
 5 sentation Act Amendment Act 1868."
- 2. At any election of a Member to serve in the House of Representatives or any Provincial Council at which any person claims to vote as an elector upon or by virtue of a miner's right or business license any agent appointed under the thirtcenth section of "The 10 Regulation of Elections Act 1858" by any candidate may at the time
- of polling call upon the Returning Officer or Deputy Returning Officer to require that the person who so claims to vote shall produce and show to such agent and permit such agent to read such miner's right or business license and the Returning Officer or Deputy
- 15 Returning Officer as the case may be shall thereupon require such person so claiming to vote to produce his miner's right or business license as the case may be and show the same to such agent and permit him to read the same and no such person so claiming to vote as aforesaid who shall be required by such Returning Officer or 20 Deputy Returning Officer to produce his miner's right or business
- 20 Deputy Returning Officer to produce his miner's right or business license and show the same to such agent and allow such agent to read the same as aforesaid shall be permitted to vote until he shall have so done.
