

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to declare certain Lands in the Province of Marlborough set apart as Reserves from time to time by Superintendents of that Province open for Sale as Waste Lands of the Crown.

Title.

WHEREAS certain lands situate in the Province of Marlborough and specified in the first Schedule to this Act have from time to time been set apart as public reserves under the provisions of the laws for the time being in force in that Province relating to the waste lands of the Crown And whereas by a proclamation of the Superintendent of the said Province published on or about the twenty-seventh day of February one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six in the Marlborough Provincial Government *Gazette* it was declared that such reserves should from and after that time be deemed to be waste lands of the Crown and be dealt with in accordance with the Land Regulations then in force in the said Province as if the same had not been reserved as aforesaid And whereas the lands specified in the second Schedule to this Act being part of the lands so reserved as aforesaid have since the publication of the said proclamation been sold and disposed of under the Land Regulations in force within the said Province And whereas it is expedient that the lands so reserved as aforesaid should from the date of the publication of the said proclamation be deemed to have been waste lands of the Crown to be disposed of and otherwise dealt with in accordance with the Waste Lands Regulations for the time being in force for regulating the sale and disposal of waste lands of the Crown in the said Province notwithstanding the reservation of the same as aforesaid and that the sale of such parts of the said lands as are specified in the second Schedule to this Act should be confirmed :

Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be “The Marlborough Reserves Act 1868.”

Short Title.

2. The lands specified in the first Schedule to this Act shall be and be deemed to have been since the publication of the said proclamation of the twenty-seventh day of February one thousand eight hundred and sixty-six waste lands of the Crown and liable to be dealt with and disposed of as such in accordance with the regulations for the time being in force in the said Province of Marlborough for regulating the sale and disposal of waste lands of the Crown in the said Province.

Lands heretofore reserved to be deemed waste lands of the Crown.

3. The sales heretofore made of the lands mentioned and specified in the second Schedule to this Act shall be deemed to have been valid and effectual to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Sales of land validated.

4. It shall be lawful for the Governor to make grants to the purchaser or purchasers of any portion or portions which already have been or hereafter may be sold or disposed of pursuant to the said Land Regulations since the publication of the said proclamation.

Governor may issue grants to purchasers thereof.
