- 5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—
 - 1. This Act may be cited as the Maori Representation Act, Short Title. 1919.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section operation of 10 twenty-five of the Legislature Amendment Act, 1914, the first section 25 of the Legislature general election of members of Parliament to represent the Maori Amendment Act, race, to be held after the passing of this Act, shall be held in the 1914, postponed. same manner in all respects as if the said section twenty-five had 15 not been passed.
