A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Holders of Miners' Rights Title.
 issued in any part of New Zealand to exercise the
 same within the Gold Fields in any part of the
 Colony.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in
 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
 follows :—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Miners' Rights Short Title.
 Extension Act, 1873."
2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in "The Miner's right to be
in force in any part
of the Colony.
 Gold Fields Act, 1866," or in any other Act, or in any regulations
 under the said Acts, the holder of any miner's right issued in any part
 of New Zealand under the said Act, or any Act amending the same,
 may, subject to the conditions hereinafter provided, during the con-
 tinuance of such right, exercise have hold and enjoy, under and in
 respect thereof, within any proclaimed gold field in the Colony, all the
 rights powers and authorities conferred by the said Act or Acts, or by
 the regulations aforesaid, upon the holder of a miner's right:
 Provided, however, that before the holder of a miner's right shall be
 entitled to exercise the same in any part of the Colony, other than that
 wherein such right has been originally issued, it shall be obligatory
 upon him to register the same with such officer, and in such manner,
 as shall from time to time be prescribed by regulations to be made by
 the Governor.
3. Nothing herein contained shall authorize the holder of a Native lands
exempted.
 miner's right to exercise such right over lands the Native title
 whereof has not been extinguished.
