Title. 1. Short Title. Fee for miner's right.
Fees for business licenses.

## A BILL INTITULED

An Act to Reduce the Fees charged for Miners' Rights and Busi-Title. ness Licenses.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Miners' Rights Fees Short Title. Reduction Act, 1885."

2. Notwithstanding anything contained to the contrary in "The Fee for miner's Mines Act, 1877" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), the fee right. 10 charged and payable for a miner's right shall be the sum of ten shillings for every year for which the same is to be in force.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained to the contrary in the Fees for business said Act, the fee charged and payable for a half-yearly business license licenses. shall be the sum of one pound, and the fee charged and payable for

15 an annual business license shall be the sum of two pounds.
