A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to Reduce the Fees charged for Miners' Rights and Business Licenses. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Miners' Rights Fees Reduction Act, 1885." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained to the contrary in "The Mines Act, 1877" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), the fee charged and payable for a miner's right shall be the sum of ten shillings for every year for which the same is to be in force. Fee for miner's right.

3. Notwithstanding anything contained to the contrary in the said Act, the fee charged and payable for a half-yearly business license shall be the sum of one pound, and the fee charged and payable for an annual business license shall be the sum of two pounds. Fees for business licenses.
