Title. 1. Short Title.

Act to be read with " Education Act, 1877."

3. School Committees shall appoint special periods during school hours for bible-reading lessons.

A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to provide for the Moral Training of the Young in the Title. Public Schools.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in 5 Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Moral Training in Public Short Title. Schools Act, 1883."

2. This Act shall be read together with "The Education Act, Act to be read with

1877," and the provisions of the said Act shall be construed in harmony 10 with this Act.

3. The committee of each school district shall appoint special School Committees periods during school hours, not to exceed thirty minutes, at which shall appoint special bible-reading lessons shall be given under the supervision of the hours for bible-readteacher, and also for the inculcation of lessons in morality; but no 15 denominational religious teaching shall be given during such lessons. The periods appointed shall be either at the opening or close of school hours.

No child shall be permitted to be present at such lessons whose parent or guardian shall have objected thereto in writing.
