MARRIAGES VALIDATION ACT AMENDMENT.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Marriages Validation Act, 1905.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Marriages Validation Act Amendment Act, 1908, and shall form part of and be read together with the Marriages Validation Act, 1905 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding next after the words "which has heretofore been," in the third line thereof, the words "or shall hereafter be"; and the said section shall be read and construed accordingly:

Section 3 of principal Act amended.

Provided always that nothing in this Act contained shall be deemed to validate any marriage contracted or solemnised after the passing of the principal Act between persons who occupy towards each other any prohibited degree of relationship or affinity other than or in addition to that specified in section two of the said principal Act.

Proviso.
