A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to extend the Operation of "The Marriages Validation Act, 1905." Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Marriages Validation Act Extension Act, 1906"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Marriages Validation Act, 1905" (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"). Short Title.

2. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding next after the words "which has hitherto been," in the third line thereof, the words "or shall hereafter be"; and the said section shall be read and construed accordingly. Section 3 of principal Act amended.
