# ANALYSIS

Title. i. Short Title. 2. Minimum wages to be prescribed by Order in Council. Repeal.

#### A BILL INTITULED

An Acr to amend the Minimum Wage Act 1945. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority 5 of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Minimum Wage short Title. Amendment Act 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Minimum Wage Act 1945, No. 44 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. (1) Section two of the principal Act is hereby Minimum 10 amended by repealing subsections two and three (as wages to be substituted by the Minimum Wage Amendment Act Order in 1951), and substituting the following subsections:—

"(2) For the purposes of this section the minimum 15 rates of wages shall be such rates as may from time to time be prescribed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.

"(3) In fixing any such rates regard shall be had to any standard wage pronouncement or general order made by the Court of Arbitration that may be applicable."

(2) The Minimum Wage Amendment Act 1951 is 5

hereby consequentially repealed.
