2. Married women may hold licenses under Licensing Act.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT in Extension of "The Married Women's Property Act, 1884." Title.

5 BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Married Women's Property Act Extension Act, 1888." Short Title.

10 2. The provisions of "The Married Women's Property Act, 1884," shall be construed to admit of any married woman after the passing of this Act holding a license under the authority of "The Licensing Act, 1881," anything in the last-mentioned Act contained notwithstanding.

15 No license heretofore granted, renewed, or transferred to a married woman under the Act last mentioned shall, after the passing of this Act, be invalidated or called in question by reason only of the same having been granted, renewed, or transferred to a married woman. But nothing in this Act shall affect any legal proceedings heretofore had or now pending for the revocation of any license granted, renewed, or transferred to a married woman before the passing of this Act, or be construed to validate any license which under
20 any such proceedings may be or has been declared invalid. Married women may hold licenses under Licensing Act.
