MOUNT WELLINGTON PUBLIC DOMAIN BOARD AND THOMAS MORRIN EXCHANGE OF LAND.

ANALYSIS.

Title. Preamble. 1. Short Title. 2. Exchange of land.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to empower the Mount Wellington Public Domain Board Title. and Thomas Morrin to Exchange certain Lands in the Mount Wellington Road Board District.

5 WHEREAS the piece of land described in the First Schedule hereto Preamble. is part of a block of land, containing in area sixty-three acres three roods and seventeen perches, Crown lands set apart as a public reserve for recreation purposes, and is now under the control, management, and administration of the Mount Wellington Public Domain Board;

10 and the piece of land described in the Second Schedule hereto is vested in one Thomas Morrin: And whereas it is desirable in the interest of the general public that the land in the said First Schedule should be vested in the said Thomas Morrin in fee-simple, and that the land described in the said Second Schedule should be conveyed

15 to His Excellency the Governor of New Zealand for the same objects and purposes as land already set apart as a public reserve for recreation purposes, and under the management and administration of the Mount Wellington Public Domain Board:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New 20 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Mount Wellington Short Title. Public Domain Board and Thomas Morrin Exchange of Land Act, 1896."

25 2. It shall be lawful for His Excellency the Governor of New Exchange of land. Zealand, in the name and on behalf of Her Majesty, and he is hereby authorised, to issue a warrant (with the consent and approval of the Mount Wellington Public Domain Board) for a grant in fee-simple to the said Thomas Morrin, his executors, administrators, and assigns,

30 of the land described in the said First Schedule, in exchange for a transfer by the said Thomas Morrin to His Excellency the Governor of New Zealand of the land described in the said Second Schedule, such land in the said Second Schedule to be set apart as part of a public reserve for recreation purposes, and placed under the control, 35 management, and administration of the Mount Wellington Public

Domain Board.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece or parcel of land situated in the Parish of Waitemata, containing 3 acres 2 roods, being part of Lot 56 of Section 12, Suburbs of Auckland, Panmure, and being a portion of the Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve, which contains in all, according to plan in Government Survey Office, 63 acres 3 roods and 17 perches. Bounded: Commencing at the northernmost corner at peg XII. in centre of stone wall, and from thence by a line bearing 110° 20′ 10″, 603.9 links, partly along southern side of old post-and-wire fence to peg XI., being the boundary-line between Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve and part of Lot 50; thence by a line bearing 121° 53′ 50″, 798.2 links, partly along south-western side of post-and-wire fence to peg X., being the boundary-line between Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve and Lot 14; thence by a line bearing 162° 46′ 40″, 358 links, along centre or thereabouts of stone wall and post-and-wire fence to peg XV., being the boundary-line between Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve and Lot 13; thence by a line bearing 300′ 58″, 1760.2 links, to peg XVI., in centre of stone wall, being the boundary-line between for Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve and other part of Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve; thence by a line bearing 66° 53′ 30″, 173.25 links, along centre or thereabouts of stone wall to peg XII. (starting-point), being the boundary-line between Mount Wellington Recreation Reserve and part of Lot 50.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

ALL that piece or parcel of land situated in the Parish of Waitemata, being Lot 55, and part of Lot 56, of Section I., Small Farms, Panmure, containing 3 acres 2 roods and 9 perches. Bounded: Commencing at the northernmost corner at peg I. in centre of stone wall, and from thence by a line bearing 146° 26′ 10″, 600 links, along centre or thereabouts of stone wall to peg II., being the boundary-line between Lot 55 and Lot 54; thence by a line bearing 234° 46′ 20″, 588 links, along centre or thereabouts of stone wall to peg III., being the boundary-line between Lot 55 and part of Lot 56 and road; thence by a line bearing 326° 26′ 30″, 609·7 links, along north-east side of post-and-wire fence, commencing about 2½ links from line of fence, and ending about 1½ links from line of fence, to peg IV., in centre of stone wall, being the boundary-line between part of Lot 56 and other part of Lot 56; thence by a line bearing 55° 43′ 10″, 588 links, along centre or thereabouts of stone wall to peg I. (starting-point), being the boundary-line between Lot 55 and part of Lot 56, and Lot 51A and Lot 53.
