A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make other provision for the Apportionment Title. of the Public Debt between the Provinces of Nelson and Marlborough.

WHEREAS the annual charge for interest and sinking fund on the Preamble. VV sum of forty-five thousand pounds, part of the loan guaranteed under "The New Zealand Loan Act, 1856," has, as between the Provinces of Nelson and Marlborough, and from the day of

, one thousand eight hundred and sixty , been apportioned in the manner provided by the fifteenth section of "The New Provinces Act, 1858": And whereas, upon the coming into operation of "The Abolition of Provinces Act, 1875," such a mode of apportionment will cease to be applicable, and it is expedient that other provision should be made in that behalf:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :-

1 The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Nelson and Marl- Short Title. borough Public Debt Apportionment Act, 1876."

2 From and after the coming into operation of "The Abolition Apportionment of of Provinces Act, 1875," and subject to any Act that may be passed public debt between provincial districts of in the present session of the General Assembly, the annual charge for Nelson and interest and sinking fund on the said sum of forty-five thousand Marlborough. pounds shall be borne and charged upon the revenues arising within the provincial districts of Nelson and Marlborough in the following proportion :-

(1.) In respect of the provincial district of Nelson in the proportion of two-thirds of such annual charge.

(2.) In respect of the provincial district of Marlborough in the proportion of one-third thereof.

3 Nothing in this Act contained shall be deemed or construed Nothing in Act to affect or interfere with the operation of "The New Zealand Loan Act, Act, 1856."
