A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the Nurses and Midwives Registration Act, 1925. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand  
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as  
5 follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Nurses and Midwives Registration Short Title.  
Amendment Act, 1926, and shall be read together with and deemed part  
of the Nurses and Midwives Registration Act, 1925.

2. Subsection one of section nineteen of the Nurses and Midwives  
10 Registration Act, 1925, is hereby amended by omitting the words  
“twenty-three years,” and substituting the words “twenty-two years.”
