BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Napier Borough (Marewa Area) Empowering Amendment Act 1951, 10 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Napier Borough (Marewa Area) Empowering Act 1946 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "sixty-five thousand 15 pounds", and substituting the words "seventy-nine thousand pounds".
