A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to empower the Napier City Council to hold  
licences under the Sale of Liquor Act 1989**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

5 **1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Napier City  
Council (Sale of Liquor) Empowering Act **1992**.

**2. Council may hold licences under Sale of Liquor Act  
1989**—The Napier City Council is hereby authorised to hold  
10 *(an on-licence and a Special Licence)* on-licences and special  
licences under the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 in respect of the  
Kennedy Park premises owned by the Council at Storkey Street,  
Napier.
