ANALYSIS 2. Retransfer of certain Title. 1. Short Title. reserve authorized.

A BILL INTITULED

An Act to empower the Mayor, Councillors, and Title. Citizens of the City of Nelson to transfer back to the Dedicating Party a Road Reserve no longer required by the Corporation for that Purpose.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. This Act may be cited as the Nelson City short Title. 10 Empowering Act, 1946.

2. The Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the City Retransfer of of Nelson are hereby empowered, and authorized to certain street transfer back to Herbert Anstice, of Nelson, Rental-car authorized. Proprietor, all that piece of land containing two roods

and fifteen perches, more or less, being parts of Sections 96, 97, 99, and 1180 on the plan of the City of Nelson, being more particularly delineated on plan marked P.W.D. Number 123677, deposited in the office of the Public Works Department at Wellington, and thereon coloured pink, which was dedicated by and at the direction of the said Herbert Anstice to the Corporation for the purposes of a reserve for a street, such land being no longer required for that purpose.
