A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make certain Alterations in Streets and to vest certain  
 Lands in the Corporation of the City of Nelson. Title.

WHEREAS the River Maitai originally passed through part of the  
 5 City of Nelson between certain streets originally known as  
 Shakespeare Walk and Milton Grove, but the river subsequently  
 changed its course and now runs partly across Shakespeare Walk  
 and partly through private lands adjoining: And whereas the  
 Nelson City Council is desirous of re-forming Shakespeare Walk  
 10 along the margin of the river as it now exists, and for that purpose  
 wishes to acquire and exchange portion of a public reserve for land  
 required for the road, and to acquire certain other lands as hereafter  
 appears: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New  
 15 Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
 as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is “The Nelson City Streets  
 and Reserves Act, 1902.” Short Title.

2. The land described in Part I. of the Schedule hereto is  
 20 hereby vested in the Corporation of the City of Nelson for an estate  
 in fee-simple, and the Nelson City Council is hereby empowered to  
 exchange and convey such land on receiving from the owner of the  
 land described in Part II. of such Schedule a conveyance to the Cor-  
 poration of such land in fee-simple free from encumbrances. Land granted to Corporation to exchange.

3. The lands described in Part III. of the said Schedule (being  
 25 portions of the old bed of the Maitai River and portion of Reserve  
 Section 184 adjoining) are hereby vested in the Corporation of the  
 City of Nelson for an estate in fee-simple, and the Nelson City  
 Council may by special order close any portion of Shakespeare Walk  
 30 or other streets for the purpose of giving effect to the exchange or  
 the deviation of Shakespeare Walk hereby authorised, and may also  
 dedicate any portion of the lands hereby vested in the said Corpora-  
 tion for a public street, and may also sell or exchange and convey for  
 an estate in fee-simple any portion of the said land not required for a  
 35 street. Lands vested in Corporation.

## SCHEDULE.

## PART I.

ALL that parcel of land, containing 1 rood 22 perches, and coloured green, being part of Reserve Section 184 (proclaimed in *Nelson Gazette*, 21st December, 1866). Bounded on the north by Halifax Street, on the east by part of Section 185, and on the south-west by the present bed of the Maitai River.

## PART II.

All that parcel of land, containing 28 perches, coloured yellow, being parts of Sections 185 and 186. Bounded on the north-east by the present bed of the Maitai River, on the south by the original Shakespeare Walk, and on the west by Reserve Section 184.

## PART III.

1. All that parcel of land, numbered 1, being part of the old bed of the Maitai River, coloured red, and containing 1 acre 3 roods 20 perches. Bounded on the north and east partly by the present bed of the Maitai River and partly by the original Shakespeare Walk, on the east by the present bed of the Maitai River, and on the south and west by the original Milton Grove.

2. All that parcel of land, numbered 2, coloured red, being part of the old bed of the Maitai River, containing 1 rood 22 perches. Bounded on the north by Grove Street, on the east by the original Shakespeare Walk, on the south by the present bed of the Maitai River, and on the west by the original Shakespeare Walk.

3. All that parcel of land, numbered 3, coloured red, being part of the old bed of the Maitai River, containing 1 acre and 34 perches. Bounded on the north by the present bed of the Maitai River, on the north and west by the original Shakespeare Walk, and on the east and south by the original Milton Grove.

4. All that parcel of land, numbered 4, coloured red, being part of the old bed of the Maitai River, containing 30 perches. Bounded on the north-east by the original Shakespeare Walk, on the south by the present bed of the Maitai River, and on the west by Trafalgar Street.

5. All that parcel of land, numbered 5, coloured red, being part of the old bed of the Maitai River, containing 32 perches. Bounded on the north by the original Shakespeare Walk, on the east by Trafalgar Street, and on the south by the present bed of the Maitai River.

6. All that parcel of land, containing 1 rood 2 perches, coloured green, being part of said Reserve Section 184. Bounded on the north by the present bed of the Maitai River, on the east by Section 185, and on the south and west by the original Shakespeare Walk.

As the said several parcels of land included in the above Schedule are all shown on the plan marked \_\_\_\_\_, in the Head Office of the Department of Lands and Survey.
