A BILL INTITULED—

An Act to amend an Act called "The Time. Native Districts Regulation Act, 1858."

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the "Native District Presumble. Regulation Act 1858."

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows:-

I. The Short Title of this Act shall be the "Native Districts Short Title. Regulation Act Amendment Act 1862."

II. It shall be lawful by any Regulation made in pursuance Removal of Spirite, of the said Act to order that any Spirituous or Fermented hibited.

Liquors (whereof the sale removal and disposal shall be prohibited) and all casks and vessels containing the same which shall be sold removed or disposed of or be in progress of being sold removed or disposed of contrary to such Regulations may be seized by any person to be appointed by any Resident Magistrate in that behalf and being so seized the same shall be detained in such manner as such Resident Magistrate shall direct until the same shall be disposed of by or by direction of the Governor and the Governor is hereby empowered to dispose thereof at his pleasure accordingly.

III. It shall be lawful by any such Regulation as aforesaid Offenders may be apto order that any person guilty of any breach of such Regula-prehended tions may be apprehended and brought before any Resident Magistrate to be dealt with according to law and such person may be apprehended and dealt with accordingly.

Governor in Council IV. Regulations made by the Governor in Council in may define the District affected by Regu. pursuance of the "Native Districts Regulation Act, 1858," may take effect and be put in force within the whole of any District constituted under the said Act or in such part thereof as the Governor in Council may order.

Mixed population may resolve to be brought under Native

V. In any such District as aforesaid or in any part thereof which is inhabited by a mixed population the majority of the Europeans assembled at a public meeting to be convened how where and when the Governor shall appoint may pass a resolution signifying their desire to be brought under the operation of the said "Native Districts Regulation Act 1858" and the "Native Circuit Courts Act 1858" or either of them.

Governor may thereupon order accord-

VI. On the receipt of any such resolution it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council by order to suspend the operation of or alter such parts of the said last mentioned Acts as exclude from the operation thereof lands over which the Native Title is not for the time being extinguished or persons not of the Aboriginal race and any such order from time to time to alter or revoke.

Partial repeal of former Act.

VII. Section 7 of the said "Native Districts Regulation Act 1858" is hereby repealed.
