## A BILL INTITLED

AN ACT to extend the Time within which Rehearings of Claims under "The Native Lands Act, 1865," may be granted. Title.

**BE IT ENACTED** by the General Assembly of New Zealand, in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

**1.** The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Native Lands Acts Amendment Act, 1870." Short Title.

**2.** The twentieth section of "The Native Lands Act, 1869," is hereby repealed. Section 20 of "The Native Lands Act, 1869," repealed.

**3.** The limit of the time within which an Order in Council for a rehearing under the eighty-first section of "The Native Lands Act, 1865," may be made, shall be such as was fixed by the said eighty-first section of the said Act, anything in the said repealed section to the contrary notwithstanding. This Act shall apply to decisions made heretofore as well as hereafter. Rehearings may be granted at any time within six months after original decision.
