A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to repeal the Special Stamp Duties heretofore payable
on the Alienation of Native Lands. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Native Land Duty
Abolition Act, 1904." Short Title.

2. (1.) The duties on the alienation of Native land imposed
10 under Part III. of "The Stamp Act, 1882," shall not be chargeable
in respect of any instrument executed after the passing of this Act. Abolition of Native
land duties.

(2.) The enactments mentioned in the Schedule hereto are
hereby repealed, save as to instruments executed before the passing
of this Act.
