WHEREAS, under the provisions of "The Public Reserves Act, Preamble. 1854," all the unalienated lands within the Town of New Plymouth, including herein certain of the sections described in the Schedule hereto, were, on the twentieth day of August, one thousand 10 eight hundred and fifty-eight, granted to the Superintendent of the then Province of Taranaki upon trust as an endowment for public schools for general education: And whereas, notwithstanding such trust for education purposes, it was intended that the lands so reserved should be available for other purposes of public utility from 15 time to time found desirable by the Provincial Council: whereas, by virtue of "The Town of New Plymouth Compensation Ordinance, 1859," and of "The New Plymouth Exchanges Completion Act, 1874," certain others of the sections described in the Schedule hereto became vested in the said Superintendent upon a have by operation of several Acts, and in particular "The Education

20 similar trust: And whereas all the sections described in the Schedule Reserves Act, 1877," become vested in the School Commissioners for the Provincial District of Taranaki: And whereas the New Plymouth Hospital has been erected on some of the sections de-

25 scribed in the Schedule, with the sanction (so far as they could legally give) of the Board of the School Commissioners for the Provincial District of Taranaki, and the rest of the land is absolutely required for the use of the hospital: And whereas that part of Bulteel Street, in the said town, which lies between Mount Edgcombe

numbered four hundred and twenty-four, four hundred and twentyfive, four hundred and fifty-one, and four hundred and fifty, unoccupied except by the hospital buildings, which sections it is by this Act proposed to vest in the Hospital and Charitable Aid Board as an addition to the said Hospital Reserve H: And whereas no inconvenience to the public would be caused by closing that part of the said street: And whereas the Borough Council of New Plymouth approves of the closing of such part of the street, and is willing that the same shall be transferred to the Hospital Board, as they consider that a public benefit will accrue by this being done:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same,

The several sections of land enumerated in the Schedule hereto, being education reserves within the Town of New Plymouth. and at present legally or equitably vested in the School Commissioners for the Provincial District of Taranaki, are hereby vested for an estate in freehold in the Taranaki Hospital and Charitable Aid 20 Board, to be held by the said Board for the purposes of the New Plymouth Hospital, subject, however, to any leases now existing affecting any of the said sections.

3. All that part of Bulteel Street which lies between Mount Edgcombe Street and the reserve known as Hospital Reserve H 25 shall henceforth cease to be a public street, and is hereby vested in the Taranaki Hospital and Charitable Aid Board, to be held by the

Board for the purposes of the New Plymouth Hospital.

4. This Act shall come into operation upon such day as shall be notified in the Gazette in that behalf by the Colonial Secretary after 30 he has been satisfied that there has been vested in the said School Commissioner an equivalent in land (previously the property of the said Board) to the unimproved value of the sections mentioned in the Schedule hereto at the time of the passing of this Act.
