NEW PLYMOUTH HIGH SCHOOL BOARD LEASES.

A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to make Provision with respect to certain Leases of the
New Plymouth High School Board. Title.

5 WHEREAS by section eighteen of "The Reserves and other Lands
Sale, Disposal, and Enabling and Public Bodies Empowering Act,
1901" (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act"), it was provided
10 that on the determination of certain leases held by Daniel I. Hughes
and Edward Newing respectively the New Plymouth High School
Board should grant to the then lessees in priority new leases of the
lands: And whereas the said lands have been granted as an endow-
ment for a high school at New Plymouth, and the leases thereof
15 have been made on conditions under which (it is claimed by the
New Plymouth High School Board) it would be in equitable to that
Board that the provisions of the said section eighteen should be
carried into effect: Preamble.

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New
Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New Plymouth High
20 School Board Leases Act, 1902." Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything in section eighteen of the said
Act, the leases referred to therein shall be deemed to continue in
force at the same rent and subject to the same conditions as are
25 fixed and contained in such leases respectively until the expiration
of the next ensuing session of Parliament, and until such expiry the
provisions of the said section eighteen shall not come into operation. Existing leases
continued.
