A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The Newmarket Reserve Act, 1878."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

The local body may, with the approval of the Governor in Council, use any portion of the land described in the Schedule of "The Newmarket Reserve Act, 1878" (hereinafter called "the said Act"), not exceeding in the whole half an acre, as a site or sites for a free library, town hall, or other public buildings, and the portion so used shall be discharged of the trusts declared in section two of the said Act.</p>
