A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend the National Roads Act 1953

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
5 follows:

- 1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be
cited as the National Roads Amendment Act 1960, and shall
be read together with and deemed part of the National Roads
Act 1953* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
10 (2) This Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the
first day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty.

- 2. Customs duty on tyres, etc., imported into Cook
Islands**—Section 22 of the principal Act is hereby amended
by adding to paragraph (d) of subsection (2) the words “not
15 being moneys received under that item in respect of such
goods imported into the Cook Islands or entered therein for
home consumption”.
