A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to authorize the Exchange of the North Timaru Cemetery Reserve for other more suitable Lands. Title.

WHEREAS the land described in the *First* Schedule hereto has been set apart as a public cemetery, and the care and management thereof have been vested in trustees appointed in pursuance of "The Cemeteries Act, 1882:" And whereas the said land is unsuitable as a place for the interment of the dead, and authority was granted by "The North Timaru Cemetery Sale Act, 1882," to sell the same, and efforts have been made in that behalf, which have proved fruitless: And whereas an offer has been made by Frederick Banks, the owner of the land described in the *Second* Schedule, which is suitable for a cemetery, to exchange the said land for that in the *First* Schedule described, and it is desirable that such exchange should be effected:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The North Timaru Cemetery Exchange Act, 1886." Short Title.

2. The Governor may, under the authority of section four of "The Public Reserves Act, 1881," make an exchange of the lands described in the *First* Schedule for the lands described in the *Second* Schedule with the owner thereof, and for such purpose may execute any necessary grant or other instrument. Exchange of North Timaru Cemetery Reserve authorized.

3. The land in the *Second* Schedule described, when acquired under the authority of this Act, shall be conveyed and assured to Her Majesty in trust as a site for a public cemetery, to be dealt with under the provisions of "The Cemeteries Act, 1882," and shall from the date of such conveyance vest in the Trustees appointed for the

maintenance and care of the said cemetery under and for the purposes of the said Act.

Repeal.

4. "The North Timaru Cemetery Sale Act, 1882," is hereby repealed.

SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

CEMETERY SITE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Arowhenua Survey District, Provincial District of Canterbury, containing 5 acres, more or less. Bounded Northward by Section No. 1701; Eastward by Section No. 965; and Southward and Westward by a road-line: and numbered 146 (in red) on the official map in the Survey Office, Christchurch.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

LAND PROPOSED TO BE EXCHANGED.

ALL that parcel of land in the suburbs of Timaru, containing by admeasurement 5 acres 2 roods 14 perches, more or less, being Section No. 2367. Bounded towards the North by the Town Belt; towards the East by Section No. 1702; towards the South by a cliff along the beach of the Otipua Lagoon; and towards the West by Section No. 122, Cemetery Reserve: as the same is delineated on the plans in the Survey Office, Christchurch.
