A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend "The New Zealand Consols Act, 1894."

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New Zealand Consols Act Amendment Act, 1899."

Short Title.

2. The total amount which, under the powers in that behalf conferred upon him by section three of "The New Zealand Consols Act, 1894," the Governor may from time to time by Order in Council authorise the Colonial Treasurer to receive by way of deposit, is hereby increased from five hundred thousand pounds to one million pounds sterling, and that section is hereby modified accordingly.

Deposits may be received up to £1,000,000.
