### A BILL INTITULED

**An Act to dissolve the New Zealand Council for  
Postgraduate Medical Education and to repeal the New  
Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education  
Act 1978.**

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the New Zealand  
Council for Postgraduate Medical Education Act Repeal Act  
1989.

**138. Dissolution of New Zealand Council for  
Postgraduate Medical Education**—(1) The New Zealand  
Council for Postgraduate Medical Education is hereby  
dissolved.

(2) On the coming into force of this section—

2 *New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education Act*  
*Repeal*

- (a) All assets and liabilities of the New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education shall become assets and liabilities of the Crown:
  - (b) All money payable to the New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education shall become 5 payable to the Crown:
  - (c) All proceedings pending by or against the New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education may be carried on, completed, or enforced by or against the Crown. 10
- (3) No member of the New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education shall be entitled to compensation for loss of office resulting from the dissolution of that Council.

**134. Final accounts of New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education**—(1) As soon as reasonably practicable after the commencement of this section, the Director-General of Health shall cause to be prepared final accounts of the New Zealand Council for Postgraduate Medical Education as at the close of the date of commencement of this Act. 20

(2) A copy of the final accounts, together with a copy of the report of the Audit Office on those accounts, shall be sent by the Director-General of Health to the Minister of Health.

(3) A copy of the final accounts, together with a copy of the report of the Audit Office on those accounts, shall be laid 25 before the House of Representatives by the Minister of Health as soon as practicable after their receipt by that Minister.
