A BILL INTITULED

An Act to amend "The New Zealand Company's Land Claimants Title. Act, 1892."

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The New Zealand Company's Short Title. Land Claimants Act 1892 Amendment Act, 1894."

2. Section six of "The New Zealand Company's Land Claimants Extension of time. Act, 1892" (hereinafter termed "the said Act"), is hereby amended by striking out the word "ninety-four," in the fourth line thereof, and inserting in place thereof the word "ninety-six," and the said Act shall be read as if such words had been originally inserted in the said section.

3. To enable the Commissioner to give effect to the said Act and Section 6 of "The this Act, section six of "The Land Orders and Scrip Act, 1858," is Land Orders and Scrip Act, 1858," hereby re-enacted, and shall have full force and effect until the re-enacted. thirtieth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six.
