A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand Institute Act, 1908.

Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1. This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Institute Amendment Act, 1930, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Institute Act, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

Short Title.

2. Section two of the principal Act is hereby amended by including in the list of incorporated societies in subsection one a reference to the Manawatu Philosophical Society, and by omitting from that list the references to the Westland Institute and the Southland Institute.

Section 2 of principal Act (as to constitution of Institute) amended.

3. Section three of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—

Section 3 of principal Act (as to constitution of Board) amended.

(a) By omitting the reference to the Minister of Internal Affairs, and substituting a reference to the Minister for the time being in charge of the Department of Scientific and Industrial Research ; and

(b) By adding the following paragraph :—

“ One additional member may from time to time be appointed by the Board for a term not exceeding two years, save that any such member may, on the expiration of his term of office, be reappointed as a member of the Board.”

4. Section four of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “ Board ” in subsection two, the words “ other than a member appointed by the Board ”.

Section 4 of principal Act consequentially amended.

5. Section six of the principal Act is hereby amended by adding to subsection one the following words : “ The Board may also appoint a Vice-President.”

Power to appoint Vice-President of Institute.

Alteration of date
of annual meeting.

6. Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—
- (a) By omitting from subsection one the word "January", and substituting the words "April or the month of May"; and
 - (b) By omitting from subsection three the word "preceding", and substituting the words "ended on the thirty-first day of March then last past".
