A BILL INTITULED

AN ACT to amend the New Zealand Institute of Architects Act, 1913. Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand
5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Institute of Architects Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with
and deemed part of the New Zealand Institute of Architects Act,
10 1913. Short Title.

2. Section three of the New Zealand Institute of Architects Act, 1913, is hereby amended by omitting from paragraphs (f) and (g) of subsection one the words "five years," and in each case substituting the words "eight years." Extension of time within which students of architecture may be registered without examination.
