- BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand 5 in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-
- 1. This Act may be cited as the New Zealand Institute of Short Title. Architects Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the New Zealand Institute of Architects Act, 10 1913.
  - 2. Section three of the New Zealand Institute of Architects Extension of time Act, 1913, is hereby amended by omitting from paragraphs (f) and within which students of (g) of subsection one the words "five years," and in each case architecture may be substituting the words "eight years."
